



MIMA RADIOLOGY AND DIGITAL IMAGING SERVICES

MIMA Radiology has successfully moved from the production of hard copy films to digital imaging. Now, when you have any type of radiology testing performed, MIMA Radiology no longer prints images on “hard copy” x-ray film. Instead, the images are created in a complex digital system, which allows the Radiologists and other Physicians to view the images from password protected computer terminals. This accessibility of medical images benefits both patients and Physicians alike. Additionally, all images that were originally recorded on x-ray film will be “digitized” and become part of the patient’s permanent digital image history.

CD REQUESTS

When a patient or Physician requests images, these images will be placed on a CD-ROM. This image CD will contain all the requested exams. The CD is a legal “original” and can be provided within 48 hours of the request. The CD also contains a report for all exams represented on the disc.

The CD is provided to the patient and/or medical provider at no charge. The CD contains simple step by step instructions and a viewing program, which requires 64mb of computer memory.

HARD COPY FILM REQUESTS

We have the ability to print the digital images on film. These printed images are also considered legal originals and can be provided within 48 hours of the request. Due to the cost associated with printing images on film media, there is a nominal charge for this service.
